**LAKE ELSINORE WETLANDS ENHANCEMENT PROJECT**



The STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD provided a water resource Proposition 85 Grant of \$1,000,000 to the LAKE ELSINORE SAN JACINTO WATERSHED AUTHORITY (LESWA) for the purpose of implementing an efficient and cost-effective land management practice (LMP) strategy to help address Lake Elsinore's Inland Salt Maximum Daily Load (IMSL) to improve water quality. The CITY OF LAKE ELSINORE is the local lead agency implementing the project.

The project will create 2,800 linear feet of riparian channels and approximately 8,000 linear feet of riparian channel islands. By subsequent channeling to expand riparian and aquatic vegetation and wildlife habitat in the existing wetlands area. Additional aquatic requirements are known to improve water quality by utilizing redundancy and providing shelter for large bodied organisms that flow feed on algae.
